Australian manufacturers and households can count on reliable natural gas from Senex's Atlas expansion in Queensland's Surat Basin with first gas now flowing to the domestic market.

Senex customers like glass manufacturer Orora have begun receiving reliable and secure natural gas as part of their decade-long supply deal with Senex to support their manufacturing operations and decarbonisation ambitions.

Senex is proud our expansion is:

- creating 700 construction jobs and 200 ongoing
- spending **95 per cent of the \$1 billion project** within **Australia** and **half within Queensland**
- injecting **\$200 million** into **Surat Basin businesses** and **communities**
- paying royalties to help fund hospitals, roads, emergency services and more
- delivering **much needed natural gas** supply for households and manufacturers on the east coast.

At this week's <u>Australian</u> <u>Domestic Gas Outlook (ADGO)</u> conference, Senex Energy CEO Darren Stevenson <u>made the</u> <u>case</u> that the 'average Australian' - a 39-year-old female with a partner and two kids who lives in our capital cities - was reliant upon and benefited from the essential energy supplied by natural gas.

Did you know?

Stadium Australia (now known as Accor Stadium) was Australia's last purposebuilt Olympic stadium constructed with **12,000 tonnes of structural steel** and **10,000 tonnes of reinforcing steel**, and designed to host **110,000 spectators in** the heart of Sydney.

Construction of the stadium also required **90,000 cubic metres of concrete** and **a million masonry concrete blocks.**

Gas is an irreplaceable high-heat source in the manufacturing process of steel, bricks and cement – without these products we could not build new stadiums.

Queensland Premier David Crisafulli has just announced Brisbane will receive a new stadium for the 2032 Brisbane Olympic Games that is sure to require thousands of tonnes of Australian steel, bricks and cement manufactured by Australian natural gas.
