## Green light for Senex's \$1 billion investment to boost domestic gas supply

Senex announced on June 26 2024, it would move ahead with its more than A\$1 billion expansion of its Atlas and Roma North natural gas developments in Queensland's Surat Basin.

Construction works are now well underway on our expansion to deliver 60 petajoules of much needed natural gas supply each year to Australian manufacturers and households from the end of 2025.

The expansion will create 700 Queensland jobs during construction with an additional 200 ongoing for the life of the project.

The multi-decade investment will inject \$200 million into local Surat Basin businesses and communities and generate millions in royalties to fund hospitals, roads, schools and emergency services.


