New gas supply on the way for the east coast

First gas is set to flow from Senex Energy's \$1 billion Atlas natural gas field expansion following the official opening of the Surat Basin processing facility last month.

We were honoured to be joined by our valued community members, landholders, representatives from all levels of government and shareholders from POSCO International Corporation and Hancock Prospecting at our facility undergoing commissioning.

We are proud our expansion is:

- Creating **900 Queensland jobs**
- Spending **95 per cent of the \$1 billion project** within **Australia** and **half within Queensland**
- Injecting **\$200 million** into **Surat Basin businesses and communities**
- **Paying royalties** to help fund **hospitals, roads, emergency services** and more
- Will deliver **soresly needed natural gas** supply for households and manufacturers on the east coast

Sustainability at Senex

Protecting the environment - a core Senex value

At Senex, we are committed to upholding one of our core values - protecting the environment. We continue to look for ways to **improve the quality of our offset property** and **provide suitable habitat** for key species to shelter and breed.

In partnership with Ausecology, we recently installed **30 nest boxes** and **30 cockatubes** that were strategically placed across our offset property to increase the habitat available for greater gliders and glossy black cockatoos.

These shelters are designed to **replicate natural hollows** in large trees for these animals to nest, roost or shelter inside.

Both the nest boxes and the cockatubes are tailored to each species and positioned to allow

connectivity to areas of known populations.

It takes at least **80 years for trees to start forming hollows** - and close to **300 years to form a hollow large enough** for a cockatoo to use.

The installation of these nest boxes is just one-way Senex is improving habitat of threatened species on our offset property.
